The Shiawassee County Drain Commissioner and the Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner will each hold a Day of Review of Apportionments for residents within each County on the respective above date, time and location. The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the apportionment of benefits for each parcel and municipality within the Youngs Intercounty Drain Drainage District. The Drain Commissioners, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

**FOR SHIAWASSEE COUNTY RESIDENT:** Comments on the apportionment of benefits may be submitted to the Drain Commissioner in writing before the Day of Review at the Office of the Shiawassee County Drain Commissioner, 1024 N Shiawassee St., Corunna MI 48817 or by emailing [drains@shiawassee.net](mailto:drains@shiawassee.net), or comments may be received in writing or verbally at the Day of Review. Comments submitted in advance must be received by the Drain Commissioner prior to the Day of Review to ensure consideration.

**FOR SAGINAW COUNTY RESIDENT:** Comments on the apportionment of benefits may be submitted to the Public Works Commissioner in writing before the date of the Day of Review to the Saginaw County Public Works Commissioner at 111 S. Michigan Ave. Saginaw, MI 48602 or to [dpw@saginawcounty.com](mailto:dpw@saginawcounty.com), or comments may be submitted in writing or verbally at the Day of Review. Comments submitted in advance must be received by the Public Works Commissioner prior to the Day of Review to ensure consideration.

Shiawassee County, Saginaw County, New Haven Township and Chesaning Township are to be assessed at large.

Additional information, including a map of the Drainage District and the Notice of Letting (containing the number and length of sections, the average width of each section, and if the drain will be closed, the amount and specifications of all tile or pipe required; the location, number, type, and size of culverts or bridges to be installed, if any; and conditions upon which the contract will be awarded) can be found at:

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioners' Offices at the numbers noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance. You may appeal the Drain Commissioners' determination of apportionments to the Probate Court in the county where your property is located within ten (10) days.
